Carrick, a name associated with the Bannockburn region is represented on the label by the Carrick Bend knot. The knot also depicts the bringing together of the Central Otago 'terroir' and Carrick's careful viticultural and winemaking practices.



2007 Riesling

The aromas are of honeysuckle and citrus flowers with some subtle mineral notes. On the palate there are flavours of lemon meringue pie, limes and a core of green fruits and citrus. The fine natural acidity and mineral core is nicely balanced by the residual grape sugar to give both weight and a long clean finish.

2007 Unravalled Pinot Noir

The name is a play on our Carrick Bend Knot and represents a marketing decision to produce a very reasonably priced uncomplicated, upfront ("unravalled!"), enjoyable wine, with recognisable black cherry fruit and ready to drink now.

2008 Unravalled Pinot Noir

This wine displays lots of vibrant fruit from red cherry, raspberry to blackberries with a hint of spice underneath. The front palate is packed with sweet bright fruit with the same red cherries and blackberries on the nose following through to the flavours. The soft tannins give this wine lovely mid-palate weight with a dark cocoa finish. This is a vibrant, fruit driven wine that can be cellared or enjoyed in its youth.

2006 Pinot Noir

The 2006 vintage was characterised by an early harvest of moderate yields. Bunch weights were around 100 grams. The weather was warm throughout the season with an early bud break and a mild December provided good fruit set and the average bunch weights. Autumn was mild and dry providing ripe fruit with great flavour intensity.
