2008 Firestick Sauvignon Blanc/ Semillon

Lime green in colour, the wine has lifted lime and lemon grass aromas. These lead to a refreshing palate which exhibits both passion fruit and gooseberry flavours, with a fresh acidity providing a clean, crisp and dry finish.

2008 Cockfighter's Ghost Pinot Gris

Straw lime green in colour, the wine has lifted orange and apricot aromas. The palate is rich with marmalade and pear flavours with fresh acidity providing a clean, crisp dry finish. Enjoy this Cockfighter's Ghost Pinot Gris as a young refreshing wine.

2008 Cockfighter's Ghost Semillon

Cockfighter's Ghost Semillon 2008, is pale lime green in colour, this unwooded Semillon has aromas of citrus, lime and pineapple. These tropical fruit characters, combine with fresh acidity on the palate to provide a dry, crisp and well balanced finish.

2005 Cockfighter's Ghost Verdelho

Cockfighter's Ghost Verdelho 2008 is pale green in colour. The wine has lifted aromas, with tropical and citrus fruits. Fruit characters of pineapple, pear and melon flow onto the palate which combine with natural acidity giving a crisp and dry finish.

2006 Cockfighter's Ghost Cabernet Sauvignon

Cockfighter's Ghost Langhorne Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 is deep purple black in colour; the wine has intense blackcurrant and other dark berry fruit aromas on the nose with underlying white pepper. These fruit flavours follow on the palate, together with some spicy vanillin oak flavours. The wine is rich yet elegant and finishes with fine-grained tannins. This is a wine which will continue to improve for ten to twelve years in the cellar if stored in optimum conditions.

2005 Cockfighter's Ghost Shiraz

Cockfighter's Ghost McLaren Vale Shiraz 2005 is dark in colour with a deep red hue. There is sweet berry fruit on the nose, together with spice and white pepper and some earthiness, which provides added complexity. Sweet plum and stewed rhubarb fruit characters are found on the palate together with more white pepper. These primary flavours are balanced by subtle oak characters and savoury tannins, which provide good structure and length on the palate. This wine will continue to improve for up to six years in the cellar if stored in optimum conditions.
